

From the Pastor's Study...

One of the great urges of Europeans before Columbus was to cross the forbidding Atlantic Ocean to find out what lay d see the sun set, but nothing more.

So if there was anything beyond that, they could not know. As usual, theologians and other scholars weighed in on things they didn't know about, claiming that if you reached the edge of the horizon in a boat, you would fall off the edge of the earth. They were so persuasive that it became inscribed on Spain's national coat of arms: *Ne plus ultra*, meaning "There is nothing beyond."

That belief held even as that Italian adventurer sailed toward that same horizon and for many months after, as nobody saw any further sign of him or his ships. In fact, it held until one day when one of those ships reappeared on that horizon. His reports to the king of Spain were glowing, speaking of the land beyond—for indeed there was land—of immense riches, just waiting to plucked. It was a new Eden. The coat of arms? It was changed. After Columbus returned, for a time, it read *Plus ultra*, "There is more beyond."

Since the beginning of time, and still to this very day, people gather as their loved one, friend, or respected acquaintance is lowered into a hole in the earth, and shared the same question: Beyond this lonely hole in the ground, is there anything else?

There came a time when a young holy man, a rabbi, set off into the setting sun, went beyond the horizon, and disappeared. But three days later, as the sun rose over the other horizon, there was only an empty grave. Finally, his earlier words made sense, that *"in my Father's house there are many dwelling places,"* and *"I go to prepare a place for you,"* signified there was indeed something more.

Makes that coat of arms take on new significance, doesn't it? "There is more beyond .... "

They join the current deacons James Duerson, Larry Edmonds, Tom Pitcher, and Linda Mason.


