Special Called Business Meeting Results

During Goshen Baptist Association's Special Called Business Meeting February 21st, the messengers unanimously voted to accept the application for membership from Mountain View Community Church. Mountain View will be under watch care for one year before a vote for full membership. Next, messengers heard from the DoM search committee, then the candidate before messengers unanimously voted to extend a call to Dr. Dee Whitten as Goshen's Director of Missions. He will begin his ministry with Goshen on March 1, 2023.

The Goshen Missions Team asked Betsy McGuiness of Rhoadesville Baptist to represent Goshen on a team of Virginia Baptists to go to Romania and witness Project Ruth's ministry to the Ukrainians. The Virginia mission team visited the Odessa Baptist Church Refugee Center in Ukraine along with a few of the Romanians from Project Ruth responsible for providing the 4:7 care boxes. Deadline approaching for Armenia Mission Team sign up

The Goshen Missions Committee is seeking volunteers who are feeling the leading of the Lord to go to Armenia on a Mission Team this August 17-27 or 29.

The Team will be working with one of our three church planters, Pastor Vardan and his wife Lusine.

There will be four parts to the team:

- 1. Holding a VBS with children & youth;
- 2. Ladies who will work with the local women;
- 3. Pastors/teachers to hold conferences for the pastors and doing some outreach;
- 4. Construction team to work on small repair projects.

The cost of the trip is estimated at \$2,000.

The team will be staying in a hotel in Sisian. There are no special shots required for entry into the country. You will need a current passport.

Please pray the Lord would build this team and Goshen people would be receptive to His calling. If the Lord is calling you, He will provide and work everything out for His glory.

The Missions Committee has set the deadline of March 31 to sign up so that airline tickets may be purchased at a better rate.

BABY BOXES

As a part of the BGAV's new disaster response program for supply distribution, Goshen is collecting supplies for baby boxes so families can have the essentials to care for their baby during a crisis. This is a brand new idea and Goshen is the first to put together these needed supplies.

The boxes (we will provide) are to contain:

a 4 ounce tube of Desitin or store brand version (which is much cheaper)

1 pacifier (sealed in packaging)

1 bottle (8-ounce sealed in packaging)

1 blanket

1 sm. box of disposable diaper sacks **or** 4 gal trash bags (any dollar store has the sm. trash bags for only \$1)

3 packs wipes (unscented 50-100 count each)

2 packs of name brand diapers (25-35 count)

We have purchased 240 boxes and 240 "Hope" New Testaments to put in each box. We plan to pack boxes in the spring (depending on donations) to be prepared for hurricane season.

Save items until a packing is scheduled or bring to Goshen Ministry Center during office hours. For any questions, call, 540.894.8440. You may also donate funds and we will shop for you - the cost is approximately \$50 per box.

Important Side Note

If you are saving your items to bring on packing day—please note that the baby blankets need to be laundered in baby-friendly detergent, then sealed in a zipper bag, and labeled "Laundered in ____ and ready to use." Substitute the blank with whatever detergents & softeners you used. Thank you for your consideration to these young families which may have no access to laundry facilities during their crisis. If you bring the blankets earlier than the packing date—they will be laundered and packed for you.

This is an ongoing project as long as it is supported by your donations.

Stewards of Children Training
