


The Greatest Day

The Resurrection of Jesus from the Grave is the greatest day in history. Jesus' victory over sin and death confirmed that He is indeed the Son of God whose forgiveness of sin provides eternal life. It is not a mere theory or a metaphor of hope. Jesus is the true and living Son of God and the faith confession of Jesus as the Resurrected Son of God provides salvation for all who believe. It is the truth, and it changes a person's eternity. Jesus' resurrection guarantees that believers will one day also be resurrected from the dead.

In the American culture, we celebrate Resurrection Day as Easter. Many enjoy it as a holiday without fully understanding what took place on that day. For the church, it is a Holy Day in which to give praise and glory to God! Jesus' birth without the resurrection would simply make him another man in history. The cross without the resurrection is simply an act of loving sacrifice, like many others.

The resurrection confirms that the babe of Bethlehem announced by angels and witnessed by shepherds is God's Son, the Savior who came to take away the sin of the world. The resurrection confirms that Jesus' death on the cross was an atoning sacrifice for our sin. When he said, "It is Finished," we can believe that Jesus did all that



is necessary to provide, by grace, everlasting life to those who believe.

Join the Elk Creek congregation in our celebrations. Good Friday we remember the Cross and Jesus' seven declarations. Early Easter Sunday our lakeside Sunrise Service will start our day of celebration. A joint worship at 11:00 will unite us in hearing afresh the good news that we serve the living Lord!

Do you want to fast this Lent? This is what Pope Francis says:

Published on February 17, 2021

"What are you giving up for Lent?" It's a question a lot of people will get these next few days. If you want to change your body, perhaps alcohol, sweets and cigarettes is the way to go. But if you



want to change your heart, a harder fast is needed. This narrow road is gritty, but it isn't sterile. It will make room in ourselves to experience a love that can make us whole and set us free. So, if we're going to fast from anything this Lent, Pope Francis suggests that even more than sweets or alcohol, we fast from indifference towards others.

In his annual Lenten message, the Pope said: "Indifference to our neighbour and to God also represents a real temptation for us Christians. Each year during Lent we need to hear once more the voice of the prophets who cry out and trouble our conscience." These are the words of the Pope:

Fast from hurting words ... and say kind words, Fast from sadness ... and be filled with gratitude, Fast from anger ... and be filled with patience, Fast from pessimism ... and be filled with hope, Fast from worries ... and have trust in God, Fast from complaints ... and contemplate simplicity, Fast from pressures ... and be prayerful, Fast from bitterness ... and fill your hearts with joy, Fast from selfishness ... and be compassionate to others, Fast from grudges ... and be reconciled, Fast from words ... and be silent so you can listen!

POTLUCK!! This casserole was a hit at the last Women's Fellowship. Note that preparation is a day ahead which can be very advantageous with guests in the house.

Tater Tot Breakfast Casserole

Ingredients:

One 16-ounce bag frozen Tater Tots® Butter, for the baking dish

1 tablespoon olive oil

1 pound spicy bulk breakfast sausage

1 medium onion, very finely diced

1 cup milk

1/2 cup half-and-half

1/4 teaspoon seasoned salt

1/4 teaspoon cayenne

4 large eggs

1 red bell pepper, very finely diced

1 green bell pepper, very finely diced

2 cups grated Cheddar cheese

1 cup grated pepper jack cheese

Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper



Directions:

- 1 Line up the tater tots in a buttered 9-by-13-inch baking dish.
- 2 Add the olive oil to a large skillet over medium heat.
- 3 Add the sausage and onion and cook, breaking the sausage up with a wooden spoon, until browned and cooked through, 8 to 10 minutes. Set aside to cool slightly, then sprinkle it over the tater tots.
- In a large bowl, mix the milk, half-and-half, seasoned salt, cayenne, eggs, bell peppers, half of both cheeses and some salt and pepper. Pour over the tots and sausage mixture, then top with the rest of the cheese. **Cover with foil and refrigerate overnight.**
- 5 Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F.
- Bake, covered, for about 25 minutes. Remove the foil and continue to bake until the cheese is brown and bubbly and the casserole is cooked through, another 20 to 35 minutes. Cut into squares and serve
