Elk Creek Baptist Church Moving Forward

Jesus said, "Whoever wants to be great among you must be your servant." Matthew 20:26 NIV)

Several years ago, in one of the church business meetings, it was voted to "move forward" with a reorganization that would encourage more participation in the life of the church. To accommodate the growth of the congregation, a way to connect and share responsibilities was proposed. "Stewardships" were agreed to advance the health, growth and joy of the congregation. People were invited to volunteer, or connect in one or more of the areas.

More recently, it was voted to move forward with the suggested Stewardships with the understanding that there would be reviews that could lead to tweaks or changes in the description and make up of each Stewardship area. It was a matter of trust and faith; any changes were to be brought to the congregation for a vote.

Unlike committees that are designed to maintain a status quo and are limited in participation, Stewardships encourage the use of one's grace gifts and talents for ministry in a particular area. The focus moves from program to people cooperating together in unity to glorify God. A formal nominating process moved to an open invitation to connect by volunteering.

On May 22nd, a first review was held with the leaders of the Stewardships meeting with the Deacons and myself. What a great meeting as the servant hearts and actions of those sitting around the table were celebrated. Testimonies were given of "God moments" in serving that were both encouraging and inspiring.

Strengths and weaknesses within the Stewardship were identified, most of the discussion concerning communication. Six individual Stewardship follow-up meetings were requested: Communication and Publicity, Worship, Audio-Visual, Finance, Buildings and Grounds and Spiritual Education.

When a church changes, not in faith, but in functionality, there is always a need to clarify responsibility in who does what and their authority to act within the church governance structure. Because of the great cooperative spirit of the Elk Creek family, the Stewardships are still moving forward in that learning process.

What are the next steps and what can you do? First, pray for the process. Second, check out the Stewardships and see where you would be a good fit, and connect. A description of the ten Stewardships along with leader of each is posted in Duerson Hall. With summer around the corner and the current Lakeside Worship set up responsibilities, the Audio-Visual Stewardship especially needs volunteers. To be a part of any of the Stewardships, send an email of text to me, or speak to one of the Stewardship leaders listed below. And remember this is a work in progress.

Elk Creek Baptist Church Stewardship Service Areas

As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as **good stewards of the manifold grace of God**. 1 Peter 4:10 (NKJV)

Worship – Mindy Ward – responsible for reviewing and evaluating the church worship services with a view to enhancing and strengthening them; includes services, bulletins/songsheets, music, communion, flowers, decorating sanctuary.

Pastor-Staff -Church Relations – works with the pastor in keeping the covenant between the pastor and church up-to-date and abiding by the guidelines adopted for the relationship as noted in the covenant agreement; includes representation from the Deacons, Trustees, Treasurer, and other active church members to serve in support of the pastor, and staff for the needs of the church.

Spiritual Education – Tony Wilson – responsible for coordinating Sunday School Teachers, Bible Study leaders and Pastor-led studies for the understanding of the Bible and spiritual growth.

Audio-Visual – Gerry Wyckoff - responsible for seeing to the maintenance, security and use of any audio/visual equipment owned by the church for the enhancement and broadcasting of services as appropriate; volunteers with the knowledge and assistance of the audio/visual equipment desirable.

Building and Grounds – Jay Canova - responsible for the maintenance and beautification of the church's building and grounds, including the Lakefront Worship area. Periodically inspect the facilities for possible repairs and upgrading as well as scheduling work days for the purpose of maintaining the building and grounds. Ensures that the facilities are properly secured when not in use, are clean and neat for services, and thermostats are set appropriately when not in use. Major areas of focus are: Electricity, HVAC, Building and Grounds Maintenance, Facility Protection, and Cleaning Teams.

Communications and Publicity – Donna Duerson – responsible for providing liaison between the church and the media including: Website, Facebook, newsletter, directory, newspapers, television, radio, etc., updating posted information to include planned special events, services and ministries.

Missions and Community Outreach – (leader needed) - responsible for planning and promoting mission ministries through Goshen Baptist Association, Baptist General Association of Virginia, Cooperative Baptist Fellowship, and other agencies as appropriate through special emphases or direct hands-on involvement. Service responsibilities include coordinating and promoting the annual mission offerings, and promoting a ministry to contact and share the message of Christ and our church with the Lake Anna Community.

Hospitality– Coral Losinski – responsible for planning, coordination and promotion of church dinners, and special events, such as, church's Anniversary/Homecoming, Valentine Fellowship, special concerts, and programs. Areas of focus include: Kitchen needs for adequate supplies.

Caring Community – Alana Frazier - responsible for addressing the concerns of the church community. Areas of focus include: Prayer Ministry, Card Ministry, meal coordination, and selection of gifts for special occasions such as graduation, recognition of special accomplishments.

Finance– Mike Bridges - responsible for church finances and other related duties.

Security – Stan Polonsky – responsible for security of facilities and safety of worshippers.
