A word about our Salvation:

Romans 3:23- 24 For all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God, and are justified **Freely** by His grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

Galatians 5:1a It is for **Freedom** that Christ has set us **Free**.

A word about new life In Christ:

2 Corinthians 3:17 Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is **Freedom**.

1 Corinthians 6:12 I have the **Freedom** to do anything, but not everything is helpful. I have the **Freedom** to do anything, but I won't be controlled by anything.

A word about Daily Living

1 Peter 2:16 Live as **Free** men, but do not use your **Freedom** as a cover up for evil; live as servants of God.

The **Baptisms** of Paula Brewer and Linda Bridges took place during the Sunday worship on June 23rd.




