

The Shape of Love

What shape represents love for you? Is it a heart, a diamond, a ring, a hand, a square, or could it be a cross?

The usual shape that represents love is a heart. That is appropriate because "God is Love" (1 Jn. 4:16), and His heart shapes love. How so?

In other religions, people serve their gods to meet their needs or requirements.

The Bible reveals that our Heavenly Father is not needy. He gives from His sacrificial, servant heart, sending Jesus as the Savior who provides reconciliation through forgiveness and eternal life by grace. His love creates eternal relationships.

God's compassion and love are beyond measure, "not treating us as our sins deserve," while encompassing His full being (Psalm 103:10-13; Ephesians 3:18-19). So, God's love is not contained within a single shape. Yet, God's heart of love can be understood by the shape of the cross. Like the points on a compass, the vertical staff connects heaven and earth and its horizontal branch extends in opposite directions, "as far as the

Potluck Brunch and Town Hall Meeting: Creating a Master Plan for Ministry Sunday February 23, 9:30 am in Duerson Hall

A master plan for ministry impacts what we do and the building in which we do God's will as the congregation of Elk Creek Baptist Church. A church campus does not shape our ministry, but the ministry shapes the church campus. The church campus does impact how we are able to do ministry.

Values come before vision. How so? Values prioritize what we do. Valuing Worship anticipates - a worship space, Valuing Fellowship - a gathering place, Valuing Ministry – a working place, and Valuing Discipleship - a learning place. Reaching retirees and those who come to recreate at the lake anticipates accessible and age-appropriate spaces.

Buildings, a lakeside Chapel, and land, are all a blessing from God. Because we have them, we are to be good stewards, maintaining and improving all to the glory of God. Do our plans match our values, meet our needs for today and anticipate the future? Or, can we do so by well prayed through improvement or expansion? The campus then becomes a place for ministry and out of which mission takes place to impact our community and see lives changed by the gospel.

Pastor Mike will lead a short lesson from the Sunday School material that will lead us into a Town Hall type forum where we will be sharing ideas, dreams and hopes for our congregation giving opportunity for input. Here are four suggested ways to prepare.

- 1. Pray! Prayer leads to Vision and Vision Leads to Mission.
- 2. Write down your idea, hope or dream for the church to clarify it.
- 3. Come to listen with an open mind and a receptive attitude. God will use a faithful congregation to reveal the "good works he has prepared in advance for us to do."
- 4. Stewardships meet and bring impactful ideas for ministry and mission.

At the last Business Meeting the Building & Grounds Stewardship was asked to pull together a team to help create a physical Master Plan. It was quickly realized that our spiritual values and goals prioritize what we do physically. Prepare and join in the excitement of a congregation of faith working in unity to glorify God.
