



Changed by the Resurrection!

There are many expectations in life. Some would say the only expectations you can count on are death and taxes. Here is another one, the constant of change. Some don't like change, but change is a sign that you are alive. And the life change belief in Jesus as your Savior brings is eternal life.

Jesus' resurrection was a change the disciples of Jesus were not expecting. His death, burial and resurrection on the third day didn't fit their narrative for Him. His words to Martha went over their head. John 11:25-26 I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies.


