

Louisa Clean Volunteer Appreciation

Louisa Clean thanks our church for its support of the effort to keep our roads free of unsightly trash. The program has grown to more than 200 volunteers with an ever-increasing visibility of our local roads. In 2022, 442 bags of trash were collected; in 2023, with more coverage 683 bags were collected. In 2024, 1134 bags were collected and 11 new groups stepped up to become Adopt-A-Highway sponsors. Currently, working on adding an additional 8 so far in 2025.

Anyone wishing to honor Joey's memory is asked to make donations to either Elk Creek Baptist Church or the Mineral Volunteer Fire Department.








